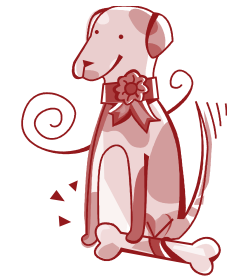

An off-leash dog park

The Hill's Bark Park is an off-leash dog park where dog owners can take their dogs to run free and socialize with others. This park is thanks to a group of women who

wished for a place for their dogs to play without the confines of a leash. This park would not have been possible without the many generous contributions made by donors, along with Hill's Pet Nutrition and the Richmond Parks Department. Please be aware of the rules prior to visiting.

Dog Park Rules

- 🐕 Dogs must be properly inoculated. Proof of rabies shot is **required** at all times. Dogs must be healthy (have no contagious diseases), and be parasite free. If tags are not on the collar, documentation must be in the owner's possession and readily available at the park.
- 🐕 Owners must clean up after their dogs.
- 🐕 Owners may take no more than three dogs per visit.
- 🐕 No children under the age of 6 permitted. Children under 12 years of age are strongly discouraged. Children should at no time be allowed to run with or chase after dogs in the park.
- 🐕 Dogs must be kept on leashes until they are released inside the fenced area.
- 🐕 Dogs may not enter the park area if they are in heat.
- 🐕 Owners are asked to closely supervise their dogs. At no time should the owner leave the park without their dog(s).
- 🐕 Do not bring rawhide or food, snacks or treats into the park as dogfights may result.
- 🐕 Please remove sharp or spike collars from your dog prior to entering the park. A basic flat buckle collar (with city license, rabies, and identification tags) is recommended. If the collar is removed, the owner must keep in their possession so proof of shots is readily available.
- 🐕 Please use the small dog/elderly dog area if you have a dog much smaller than those in the large area, or if you have a senior dog that may not be able to handle romping from the younger dogs. Owners should keep their dogs in their designated areas according to their
- 🐕 Muzzling your dog is recommended, and required if your dog shows any signs of aggression. You know how your dog behaves at home. You may not know how it behaves with a group of other dogs. **When in doubt, use a muzzle.** If it displays signs of aggression at the park, it will not be permitted to return.
- 🐕 Water supply and concessions will not be available from November 1 - April 1. Please bring your own water during this part of the year.
- 🐕 PLEASE RESPECT THE FACILITIES. Please do your part to keep it as nice as when you arrived.
